GENERAL MEET INFORMATION

- We will NOT have a hospitality room this year. Coaches please plan accordingly for food, snacks, and water. We will have a concession stand open run by the Booster Club.
- Water station to fill water bottles will be provided.
- Coaches must fill all jobs assignments.
- The bullpen will be located in the East end ("D-Zone" opposite of the start/finish line). An athlete will be given a hip number to be placed on the left hip and this will be located in the East end zone.
- Only athletes and meet officials may enter the field of competition. The south gate below the press box and the side gate by the field events will be the only access gates to the track.
- Athletes not currently participating in an event must remain outside the fenced area (unless warming up for an event).
- Coaches not currently officiating must also remain outside the fenced area and remain in designated coaching areas.
- All MSHSAA rules will apply to uniforms and electronics (including video, cell phone, etc...). There is no jewelry rule other than safety related.
- Team camps may be set up in the South bleachers or behind the press box, in the grassy areas. (refer to map). Please do not set up camp in the North side grandstand, these will be for spectators.
- In accordance with the MSHSAA guidelines, admission cost is \$5 per person.
- Buses parking
 — Please see attachment, buses in the parking lots at our elementary schools.
- Locker rooms are not available.
- Athletic trainer or Medical Personnel will be on site.
- District T-Shirts will be available at concession stands from the booster club
- Scoring: Points will be scored 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 for eight places in all events
- PLEASE USE ONLY 1/4" OR BELOW IN PYRAMID SPIKES. THEY WILL BE CHECKED IN THE BULLPEN. PLEASE DO NOT WEAR SPIKES IN THE BLEACHER AREA.
- Results will be posted on the press box wall and following the race to MOMILESPLIT.

Field Event Information

- All field events must report when called. Be sure to check in with the event judge.
- Shot and Discus are located on the East end of the stadium on the open field outside the fence.
- Long jump, Triple Jump and Pole Vault are located at the West end of the stadium.
- Javelin is located behind the press box near tent city.
- Prior to competition, each shot and discus must be inspected and approved by the head field event judge. Implement weigh-in will take place in the Field House. Implements will be carted/escorted to locations.
- Opening heights for the high jump and pole vault will be determined at the coach's meeting. Poles will need to be checked in by a meet official and this will take place near the pole vault competition area.
- All jumps are finals. Best of 3 jumps in High Jump and Pole Vault. Best of 4 in all other field events.
- Field event time to finish will be 1.5 hours. High Jump and Pole Vault if an athlete
 leaves they have 15 minutes from the time they leave to report back and jump or
 the height will be moved up (bars will not be moved back down). The athlete will
 at that time need to attempt at the new height.
- Long Jump and Triple Jump. Once run throughs are finished and the event has started there will be no more run throughs allowed.
- High Jump will move up by .05 meters and Pole Vault by .15 meters. All other field events will be measured to the nearest lesser centimeter.
- All measurements need to be in meters.
- Shot/Discus/Javelin Weigh In: 8:10am to 9:10am -- Clinton or Official- This will be located in the Field House directly inside the garage door.

Entries Deadlines

The District Meet entry process deadline is 12pm (noon). on Tuesday (May 11th) prior to the District Meet.
