Spectators

- 2 Spectators are allowed per participant. Each spectator will sign in at the entrance. We will not need names ahead of time.
- Masks are required for the duration of the activity.
- Families are required to sit together and social distance from others. No unsupervised children.
 - Spectators are required to sit ON the pre-marked seats.
- Attendees must [Pre-Screen](#) themselves prior to attending.
- No admission charge unless otherwise stated.
- No concession stands to avoid lines/gatherings.
- No spectators will be allowed on the playing floor before, during and after competition.
- Areas of bleachers will be marked off for no seating (i.e. behind benches/scorer's table).
- No spectators allowed at home wrestling tournaments unless otherwise stated.

Teams

- 15 max on benches. Benches will be set up socially distanced as much as possible.
- No visiting cheerleaders.
- No water jugs/cups available. Please bring your own bottles.
- Locker Rooms are available and will be disinfected prior and after contests.
- Teams waiting to participate should remain in the visitors section, behind your benches or in your locker rooms, supervised.
- Masks should be worn at all times except for during strenuous activity.

Acknowledgement of Infection Risks:

The risk of coronavirus transmission will still be present to some degree as school activities continue throughout the fall season. Students and their families, along with school personnel must recognize these risks and implement best practices to reasonably mitigate these risks. The primary means of coronavirus transmission is through respiratory droplets and potentially aerosolized.

Voluntary Attendance:
